

## The “Bob White” 23<sup>rd</sup> Annual Charity Golf Tournament



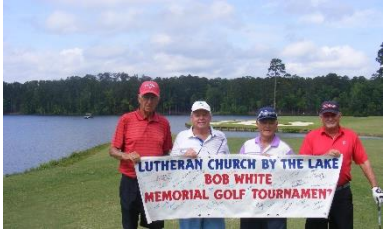
