



The Lutheran Church By The Lake sits on 6 acres donated in 1997 by the developers of Savannah Lakes Village, Cooper Communities, Inc., with the understanding that a church could be developed on this site as long as no other churches of the same



denomination were open and serving in the McCormick area.

The original building houses a beautiful sanctuary surrounded by imposing and

meaningful stained-glass windows designed by a member of the church at that time. A fellowship hall served the congregation for many years, and now serves as a library, meeting, and multi-purpose space. Additionally, a conference room, choir room, and two offices complete the floor plan. In 2020 the church saw the completion of the ARK – an open and large space with a full kitchen for large gatherings, meetings, receptions, etc. The buildings have no steps and have modern handicap accessible restrooms, including a family restroom in the ARK. There is a sidewalk ramp leading to a door near the kitchen.



Outdoors is a pavilion with picnic tables, electricity, space for grilling, and fellowship time.



Near the Twelve Oaks entrance, our Columbarium and Memory Garden surrounded by lovely stone work and landscaping with seating for meditation and prayer is quietly removed from the main campus, yet nearby to accommodate funeral services when needed.

Ample parking with handicap designations is available in front of the church.
